

On 18 February 2021, a site visit was conducted in the future police training center in Kutná Hora, with the participation of representatives of the program intermediary JUDr. Václav Vlček and Ing. Zdeňka Klimková from the Department of Financial Mechanisms and Structural Funds of the Ministry of the Interior, and the leader of the implementation team of the PDP2 project Ing. Tomáš Nushart from the Logistics Administration Department of the Police Presidium.

The inspection was attended by representatives of ten construction companies which expressed interest in the procurement procedure for a public contract supplier. The subject of the public contract is the execution of the construction within the project documentation entitled "Revitalization of the Kutná Hora complex", and creation of an inventory of construction works, supplies and services, including a statement of acreage, energy assessment and building permit. It is a reconstruction of buildings designed to provide accommodation, training and conference facilities.

In the future, the training center of the Czech Police will provide the necessary conditions for organizing didactic, training and international courses, conferences, exercises, training of police officers and police instructors, educational activities within lifelong learning, etc.
