Theft

Be careful of your personal belongings. Wallets, ID cards, mobile phones. Carry your belongings by yourself, ideally in your inside pocket. Make sure that your hand luggage is zipped or secured by the lock. Don't leave your luggage unattended. Caution has to be given while travelling by a public transport.

Respect rules of descent behavior not only on the sport stadium. Follow instructions of police officers and organizers. Cheer on your team but stay calm. Don't do anything what you would regret or could face the consequences later on. Don't disturb a public order or damage someone else's property.

Be careful of false dealers selling counterfeit tickets on 2015 IIHF Ice Hockey World Championship. False dealers may try to use your unfamiliarity. Don't react on their offers. Be aware of people who offer overpriced services. For instance, the average price per 1 km by a taxi is 25 CZK.

Don't leave any unattended belongings in your car. Your car is not a safe. Handbags, laptops, cameras may attract an attention of burglars. Don't even leave your belongings in a car's boot. Offenders can be waiting at the public parking lot and observing you.

Alcohol can be consumed from 18 years of age in the Czech Republic. Never drive under influence of alcohol. There is zero tolerance of alcohol while driving a car in the Czech Republic. Make sure that a driver was not drinking alcohol. Don't sit in a car if you are not sure that a driver is not under influence of alcohol.
